- 1. Call To Order; Introductions, Approval of Minutes of June 27, 2023: The meeting was convened at 7:46 p,m. Committee chair, Joe DeCenzo welcomed all and read through the minutes of the prior month's meeting. Following spelling corrections, K.T. Travers moved to approve the minutes as written. Gerardo Barrientos seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

- 3. **Public Comments/Updates for Non-Agenda Items**: SueEllen Hussing announced "Coffee With A Cop" at the Crow's Nest restaurant Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Joe announced the Village Poet's reading at Bolton Hall August 27<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 p.m. K.T. proudly announced that Jessica Calderon will perform at Indigenous People's Day October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023. She also stated that mulch was spread at the median project at Pali and Foothill Blvd. named "The Sunland-Tujunga Welcome Garden of Resilience and Inclusion."
- 4. Guest Speaker: Bella Chen, "Fable of the Seasons. The artists presented examples of her paintings as well as a slide show of her art as she discussed her technique and philosophy born from the journey that carried her here from China. She discussed the imprimatura style of layering an initial wash of color to her canvas. She spoke of a surrealistic stage of exploration to reconnect with childlike wonders and miracles.
