- 1. Call To Order; Introductions, Approval of Minutes of January 24, 2023:** Joe DeCenzo welcomed the guests new to the STARC Committee meeting. He read through the minutes of the prior month's meeting. Gerardo Barrientos moved to approve the minutes as corrected. Michelle Wadler seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

She credits David Simon with teaching her about molds and full figure sculpting. One of her philosophies about art is, "Be a master practicing, not practicing to be a master."
