- 4. Public Comment: Gerardo discussed possible mural and artwork projects near 7/11 and new Back Door Bakery wall. Gerry Discussed the value of a NC or Gateway to the Angeles Forest on an Adopt a Highway or Caltrans. Nelly had success with discussion clean up and beautification by the Sunland and Tujunga Post Offices, by their Postmasters. We agreed as a committee to support a certificate of recognition for the end results for these post offices and other business we meet with who make a major effort to clean up their property.
