1. Call to Order at 6:08 p.m. by STAT Chair Pat Kramer. STAT Committee members attending: Betty Markowitz, George Arakel, Pat Kramer, Levon Parian, and Gerry Sherman (at 6:20 p.m.). Quorum reached. Also attending was stakeholder Jennifer Frey of Sunland, Gerardo Barrientos of Shadow Hills and Cindy Cleghorn, STNC Secretary.

2. Introduction of STAT Committee's goals & vision & introduction of attendees.

3. Motion to approve minutes from June. 2020 meeting (committee votes only). (Betty/Gerry) approved the minutes. The motion carried.

4. Review of Gerardo's artwork for yard signs. Motion to approve one of the signs and to send to STNC for budget approval. Gerardo created three slightly different forms of artwork for our proposed yard signs. The committee voted to approve a final design that says: No Speeding, Radar Enforced, We Watch, We Care, We Call Police, 818 644-8000, Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council. Gerardo will make the changes and send the final version back to Pat.

5. Discussion and motion to approve two Community Impact Statements off the July 2, 2020 Council Referral Hot Sheet for funding three, previously requested left-hand turn signals in Sunland – Tujunga at: Oro Vista & Foothill, Mt. Gleason & Foothill and Tujunga Canyon & Foothill in CD7 as stated in CIS 20-0600-S 37 & 38: Cindy explained the purpose of creating CISes. There was no vote taken.

6. Committee Reports and Chairperson Updates. Pat shared communication from CD7 on different traffic – related issues including three, left-hand turn signals. Levon reiterated his concern for signage that has faded on Tujunga Canyon Boulevard, south of Foothill, at a sharp bend where most of the accidents have occurred. Although LADOT and CD7 responded to his emails, nothing has been done and there was no commitment to follow up.

7. Public Comment – Jennifer Frey talked about her interest in attending the meeting to be more involved in her community.
