Workshop will include discussion on potential project opportunities within Sunland-Tujunga.

The process consists of creating a workshop with the STNC's Land Use and/or Beautification committees by bringing in a high resolution map of your district to map your suggestions, project opportunities and existing constraints. This is done in an effort to learn from you about your district and to help identify potential projects for your submission and their connectivity to other proposed or existing projects in the watershed. We have found that the meetings are most effective if they are designed as an interactive workshop rather than a formal presentation so that interested members of the council and the community can look at the map and designate and/or discuss the opportunities in the community. Your project will become a part of public record.

The purpose of the watershed management plan is to define opportunities to improve water quality and capture stormwater for infiltration; create and/or improve open spaces, parks, green streets; decrease trash; increase permeable surfaces; create trails and recreational areas; and improve the overall quality of life in the watershed. The projects aim is to allow Los Angeles to reduce our dependence on imported water and provide the opportunity to improve neighborhoods in the process.
